2012- 2013 7TH Grade immunization Assessment Results California Department of Public Health, Immunization Branch

Introduction

Under Assembly Bill 354 (2010), California Health and Safety Code Section 120335 required students in 7-12th grade during the 2011-2012 school year and 7th grade for future years to provide documentation of either having received a booster immunization against pertussis or an exemption to immunization. The pertussis booster immunization recommended for adolescents is known as 'Tdap'. This report summarizes the assessment of the 7th grade pertussis immunization (Tdap) requirement based on reporting from California schools. The attached tables present immunization rates by county and grade level.

Methods

Staff from 4,704 of California's schools with 7th graders submitted immunization assessment reports to local health departments and CDPH Immunization Branch. Students were considered to have completed the Tdap immunization requirement if they had received one dose of any immunization (Tdap, DTaP or DTP) that protects against pertussis on or after their 7th birthday.

Results




Figure 2: Percentage of California 7th Graders with a PME in Public and Private Schools, 2011-12 and 2012-13 School Years





Figure 3: Percentage of California 7th Graders with a PBE in Public and Private Schools, 2011-12 and 2012-13 School Years

Table 1 summarizes and compares the results from the 2011-12 to 2012-13 7th Grade Pertussis (Tdap) assessment. Of 510,378 students enrolled in 2012-13 the 4,704 schools that reported, 495,923 (97.2%) completed the pertussis immunization (Tdap) requirement. There were 831 (0.16%) students with permanent medical exemptions (PMEs) and 13,624 (2.67%) students with personal belief exemption (PBEs) during 2012-13. The percent of students that completed pertussis immunization (Tdap) requirement remained at 97% this year, and decreased slightly by .05%. Students with PMEs increased from 0.13% to 0.16% and PBEs increased from 2.18% to 2.67% (Figure 1). A slightly higher percentage of students in public schools completed the pertussis immunization (Tdap) requirement compared with private schools during both school years (Table 1). A lower percentage of students in public schools both years received an exemption (Table 1 and Figure 2 and 3).

Figure 1: Percentage of California 7th Graders with a PME or PBE, 2011-12 and 2012-13 School Years
